This bespoke building built for the RNLI located on the edge of the river Blyth, sits on a complex arrangement of piled foundations and reinforced concrete ground beams; rigorously prepared and implemented to cope with the severe weather conditions on the North East coast.

The building combines feature blockwork, larch cladding and is topped off with a single ply roof. The interior is fitted to a high standard to meet the many varied functions of the lifeboat crew. The building benefits from an environmentally friendly sea water pump that helps provide heat all year round.



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
